Storied Streets explores homelessness across America by telling the stories of those who live it every day. The full-length film profiles those that are homeless and their struggles to survive. The stories are real, raw, and compelling. They provide a window into their challenges, question stereotypes, and will change the way we think and feel about homelessness.
