



Application Checklist

Please see the new changes to our application requirements. There is a high demand in our community for permanent supportive housing and this will ensure that the individuals with highest need are assisted. It is important to note, in order to be eligible for South Side Office of Concern's Permanent Supportive Housing Services the applicant must BOTH be **homeless** and have a **disabling condition**.

Please attach the following documents to be considered for housing:

- Pre-Application
- Copy of State I.D.
- Copy of Social Security Card
- Copy of Birth Certificate OR DD-214
- Up-To-Date Homeless Verification; *including verification of the length an individual has been homeless*
- Up-To-Date Disability Verification from a medical professional;
Disabilities include, but are not limited to:
 - A Diagnosable Substance Use Disorder
 - Serious Mental Illness
 - Developmental Disability
 - Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder
 - Cognitive Impairments Resulting From A Brain Injury
 - Chronic Physical Illness
- If Applicant is Fleeing Domestic Violence; *attach statement from service provider or self-declaration*
