

## **SOUTH SIDE OFFICE OF CONCERN CONSUMER RESPONSIBILITIES**

As a person voluntarily receiving services from the South Side Office of Concern (SSOC), you also have certain **responsibilities** in order to continue being entitled to remain in SSOC's programs.

1. You have the responsibility to complete all necessary program paperwork in a timely manner.
2. You have the responsibility to abide by all program rules and regulations.
3. You have the responsibility to participate in all scheduled group activities.
4. You have the responsibility to comply with your individual service plan goals and activities.
5. You have the responsibility to maintain the confidentiality and respect the right to privacy of other program participants.
6. You have the responsibility to abide by all the facility safety and maintenance requirements.
7. You have the responsibility to not possess any illegal drugs/substances, paraphernalia, weapons and/or other inappropriate contraband on any SSOC property or while participating in any SSOC sponsored activities.
8. You have the responsibility to be respectful, not to intimidate, not to be violent or incite violence with other program participants, SSOC staff, volunteers or visitors.
9. You have the responsibility to not destroy or vandalize any SSOC property.
10. You have the responsibility to be considerate of our neighbors in the community and the SSOC program participants in any of our housing facilities.
